

(Man-to-Man) OFFENSIVE PLAY: DIEGO




NOTES: FRAME 1

Diego can go to either side. Both posts, 4 and 5 will pick for 2 and 3 out of a double stack to open them up to the wing. 4 and 5 will pop out to the "extended elbow" after they set their picks. 1 can pass the ball to either post. Assume the ball goes to 5. The whole concept of DIEGO will be to have to 3's defensive man (X3) react to the pass.



4 must wait a count then steps out and sets a pick for 2 flashing right down the lane [Option #2]. 1 will wait a 2 count then roam the arc deep behind the post player, 5, which he passed the ball to for a relief if option #1 and option #2 aren't open. We'll set up into one of our motion offenses then.



As soon as X3 turns his head to see the pass to 5, 3 will break back door [Option #1]. It'll be open. 2 must start up to the top like he's replacing the point to set up a v-cut hard toward the key off of 4's pick.
