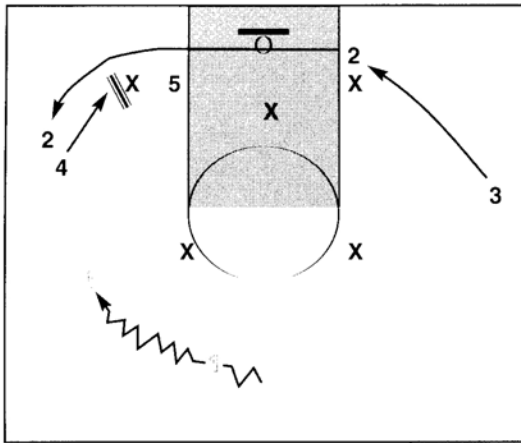


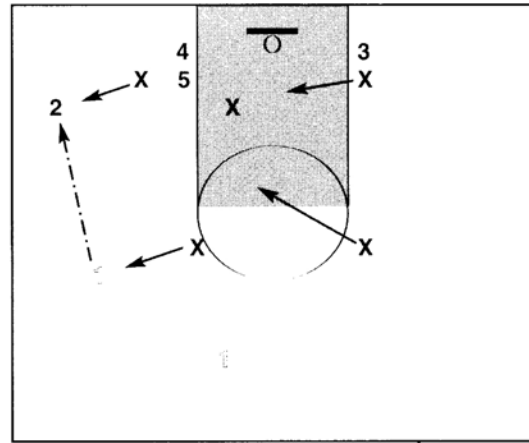
(vs. Zone) OFFENSIVE PLAY: NOW

FRAME 1

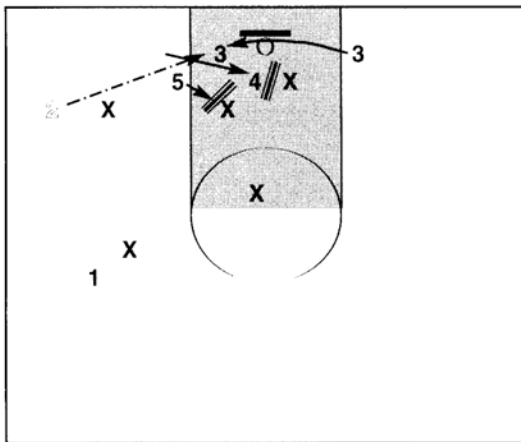
Against a zone this is a quick hitting play that will give you a layup a high percentage of the time. It works against many different zones just understand where the picks must happen. 1 dribbles to the left side of the court and 4 slides down to seal off and pick the bottom left defender to pop open 2 out on the left wing. 3 fades down to the right block.

FRAME 2

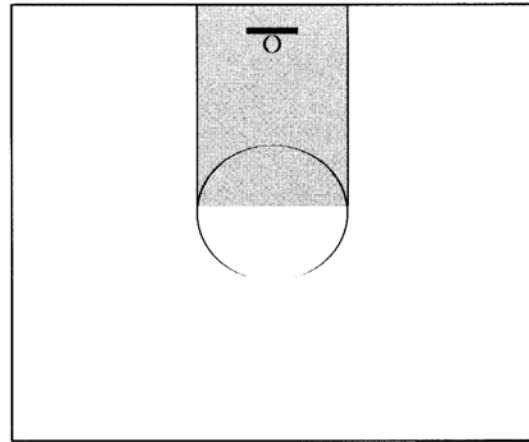
On the pass to 2 from 1, the defense reacts the court as shown above. As the pass is being made all three of the offensive players in 3, 4, and 5 start moving to set up the easy score.

FRAME 3

As you can see, timing is critical. As 2 is receiving the pass, 4 and 5 move to set picks on the two others in the zone responsible for the bottom. 3 slides underneath along the baseline wide open for the easy layup.
